#### **Other Rules and Regulations**

- Applications are made available as early as March 1<sup>st</sup>.

- Applicate will submit an Essay containing 400-500 words, typed, and double spaced on the topic and submitted with the Application Cover Sheet.
- The interviewed veteran **shall not be related** to the applicant.
